Finance Report

- The **preliminary budget** including the DMA position and assistant, STEM position, and a director of curriculum was discussed. Additional course offerings could also impact the budget.

Administration / Education Report:

- **Enrollment:** Current Total 240 (9=66, 10=65, 11=59, 12=50) includes 14 Wisconsin Parental Choice students. (all WELS)
- **Administrative Assistants:** Mrs. Dulcey Zillmer, who currently serves as the Assistant to the Athletic Director and Music Department, will also assist Mrs. Nancy Rieck with Luther High's finances. Mrs. Courtney McCollough will be assuming publication responsibilities in addition to her work as the Assistant the Director of Mission Advancement.
- **MLC Student Teacher:** Mr. Paul Adickes will serve as a student teacher supervisor in the second semester.
- **MLC New Teacher Induction Program (NTI):** This required program from MLC will provide structure and support of graduates in their first two years in the teaching ministry. Currently, Mr. Rosenbaum is in the second year of the program. Mrs. Towne and Mr. Witte are in the first year of the NTI program.
- **Mission Trips:** Connie Bader presented multiple opportunities for Luther students to be involved in mission work. The Board of Control granted permission to pursue a two-week VBS with Costa Maya, Mexico.
