**LHS Enrollment/Tuition Assistance/ WPCP Informational Meeting:** The first of two required informational meetings will be held 5:00-6:00 PM, November 14. Parents of current Luther High student as well as parents of students in grades 5-8 are invited and encouraged to attend. Mr. Terry Brown, Vice President of School Choice Wisconsin will be present to share information and answer questions. Knowing about application timelines to Luther High and Wisconsin Parental Choice program and other tuition assistance can certainly benefit current and future Luther High families.

**WPCP (Wisconsin Parental Choice Program)** –There are 14 students attending Luther High through this program. All 14 students are members of one of our LHS association congregations. The Board of Control approved a possible exit strategy and building up a reserve fund in case the WPCP ends. This fund would help provide tuition assistance for students currently in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program so they can continue their Christ-centered education at Luther High.

**Mr. Benrud:** At the conclusion of the current school year Mr. Benrud will be retiring from the teaching ministry. We are most grateful for his faithful service and pray that God continues to bless him in his future endeavors.
