Luther: "Thus under the papacy people used to perform those foolish and meaningless works, neither commanded nor demanded by God, with the utmost pleasure, diligence, and zeal, and at great cost. We recognize this same zeal for meaningless things in the sectarians of our day and in their disciples, especially in the Anabaptists. But in our churches, where the true doctrine of good works is set forth with great diligence, it is amazing how much sluggishness and lack of concern prevails.¹"
